

Welcome to the 2016 Gainesville Number Theory Conference (ALLADI60)! We look forward to having you in Gainesville for this event next week.

### **Getting to the Hotels from the Gainesville Airport**

If you are staying at: The Lodge, Wyndham Gardens (formally the Paramount Hotel), or the Hilton, shuttles are available from airport to hotel. You can call from the airport lobby (there is a phone near the luggage area) or call hotel in advance to make the arrangement.

For those hotels that do not have shuttles you can call a taxi (normally there are some in the parking lot waiting).

### **Parking at the conference**

For those that will have a car for the conference and have requested a parking pass through Margaret, we have reserved the lot around the Straughn Center. There will be a member of the TAPPS (our parking department) outside the lot from 7:30am-10:30am. **You must give them the code (the code is "ALLADI60") to be able to get in the lot.** This lot has 67 spots and some spots on the grass area.

You must enter the Straughn Center parking lot by 10:30 am to be guaranteed a parking place. During this time NO ONE else will be allowed to park in this lot.

Parking at Little Hall on Saturday and Sunday will not require anything, however there are times events are going on and we cannot guarantee parking outside our building.

### **Transportation during Conference**

We have rented a 56 person chartered bus and three 15 passenger vans that will be picking up people each morning at of our hotels and bringing them to the conference. Some participants who have cars will also be assisting with transport. We will post the detailed schedule for transportation on the conference website.

### **Check In First Day of the Conference**

We will have two tables in the lobby of the Straughn Center for check in, one will be for those that have already sent in their registration fee, the other for those who will pay the registration fee at check in. Everyone will have to sign the sign in sheet. You will pick up your name tag and conference bag containing conference materials. If you have not yet paid your conference fee, you may pay \$120 in cash or by check made payable to the UF Department of Mathematics. If you have a guest attending the conference, the cost is \$60. If your guest is attending the banquet only, the cost is \$40.
